**RULES OF STUDY
FOR THIRD STUDY CYCLE**

Sarajevo, 2017.

Pursuant to the Article 119 and Article 48 (part 4) of the Law on Higher Education of the Sarajevo Canton ("*Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton*" no. 42/13 and 13/15), in conjunction with Article 116 of the Statute of the higher education institution International Burch University, and based on the defined proposal by the Rector of the University; the Senate adopted on its CXXXVII session held on 29.03. 2017., approved the following

STUDY RULES
of the Third Cycle of Studies at the International Burch University
(Consolidated text)

I - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1.

Rules of studying at the third cycle of higher education institution "International Burch University" (hereinafter referred to as the Rules) regulate the organization and execution of the third cycle of studies, enrollment of the third cycle, the manner of conducting the examination and research, the application process and defense of the doctoral dissertation, the process of promoting PhDs, as well as other issues of importance for the realization of studies for acquiring the academic title Doctor of Science/Arts in the higher education institution "International Burch University" (hereinafter: the University).

Article 2.

The third cycle of study is considered to be any program that gives the right to acquire a diploma/academic degree and scientific title Doctor of Science for a particular area, in accordance with the Act, the Rules and Regulations on the use of academic titles and acquisition of scientific and professional titles at higher education institutions in Sarajevo Canton.

Article 3.

After completion of the third cycle of studies student:

- a) will show the ability of independent research in the field of studies, and independent application of skills and methods of research in its field;
- b) will show the ability to synthesize, explicate, designate, apply, design, implement and accept the process based on scientific predispositions;
- c) will be able to conduct original research contributions to advancing the frontiers of knowledge in scientific work, of which some parts deserve publication in national and international publications;
- d) will be capable of critical analysis, evaluation and synthesis of new and complex ideas;
- e) will be able to promote, in academic and professional contexts, technological, social or cultural advancement in a knowledge based society.

II - ADMISSION TO THIRD CYCLE STUDIES

Article 4.

- (1) Admission to the third cycle of studies is done on the basis of a public call for application announced by the University, under the decision of the Senate.

- (2) The number of students for admission to the third cycle is determined by the University Senate, with the consent of the founders of the University.

Article 5.

- (1) The right of entry to the third cycle of studies have candidates who have completed courses of the second cycle study.
- (2) Candidates who have completed the academic degree of doctor for a period of six years after the pre-Bologna system, can be enrolled in the first year of doctoral study with the approval of the Faculty Council, and fulfilling the other conditions laid down by the competition for student enrollment.
- (3) A candidate who has fulfilled the terms of paragraph 1 of this Article will have the right to enroll in the programs of other related fields that are different from the study field program of the first and second cycle studies, which he or she completed under the conditions established by the Council of the organizational unit.
- (4) The ranking of candidates shall be based on the Decision on the criteria and standards for determining the order of receipt of candidates for admission to the first year of the third cycle of studies at higher education institution International Burch University.

Article 6.

Detailed conditions for the registration of candidates from previous paragraph shall be determined by the University Senate.

Article 7.

- (1) The third cycle studies are taught in English language, except for the Department of Oriental Philology, where the teaching is conducted in Turkish.
- (2) In order for students to attend classes, they must have a certain level of knowledge of the English language, or Turkish language at the Department of Oriental Philology.
- (3) The level of the candidate's knowledge of English and Turkish language is assessed according to the results of language proficiency examination, or equivalent results achieved in other examinations of language proficiency exams specified by the University Senate.
- (4) For the admission to the degree of PhD, the Senate determines an acceptable result achieved in these tests.

Article 8.

For carrying out the process of ranking Senate may appoint a special Commission.

Article 9.

- (1) Commission from the previous article gives the final report on the results of student enrollment submitted to the Council of the organizational unit.
- (2) The final list is adopted by the Senate.

Article 10.

- (1) The candidates with the same number of points have the same right of entry.
- (2) The competition results will be published on the bulletin board of the university or college.

- (3) A candidate who believes that the ranking procedure is not performed correctly has the right to object in accordance with the legal procedure.
- (4) The decision is communicated to the complainant and published on the notice board of the University level and the Faculty.

Article 11.

- (1) Candidates who qualify for enrollment, and have not completed registration in due time, lose the right to enroll, and instead the right to enroll obtains the next qualified candidate on the ranking list.
- (2) The student signs a studying contract with the University, which closely defines their mutual rights and obligations.

Article 12.

Foreign citizens have the right to enrollment in the study of the second cycle with the same conditions as citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina in accordance with the Law.

III - TRANSFER STUDENTS

Article 13.

- (1) A student who is currently enrolled in the second cycle of studies at another higher education institution in Bosnia and Herzegovina or abroad after submitting all the necessary documents may be allowed to go only to the same or a related degree program.
- (2) A transfer student to International Burch University from another university can arrange the examination on the English language, or Turkish language if one is applying to the Department of Oriental Philology.
- (3) The credit equivalent for students moving from universities where the length of the semester is different from the IBU by the Council of the organizational unit.
- (4) Transition is approved by the dean of the faculty, based on the Decision of the Council of the organizational unit in the manner established by these Rules, the Statute and other general acts of the IBU.
- (5) Students who are currently enrolled in the second cycle of studies in one of the IBU study programs have the ability to freely choose another program of study leading to a Master of Science degree, which was launched in the context of organizational units of the IBU
- (6) The students who are enrolled in regular studies in the context of the third cycle at the IBU, have the possibility of transferring to the distance learning study in the similar program (and vice versa), with the fulfillment of the procedural and financial conditions for the transition.
- (7) Transition from paragraph 6 above is approved by the dean and the organization units and based on the student's request.

Article 14.

- (1) A student who has passed the exam at another study program, will have his or her test recognized, if the subject from which the exam is passed, is equivalent in its content and scale to the subject the student wants to enroll, as evidenced by documents provided by ECTS rules.
- (2) If the subject from which the exam is passed in its content and scope approximately corresponds to the subject that the student is now enrolled, the instructor can accept the exam as a whole if he or she finds that the student gained the necessary knowledge and skills sufficient for the recognition of exams.

- (3) By recognizing the exam, one also recognizes the score that the student is given at the exam.
- (4) The number of points of recognized exam is determined in accordance with the rules of study.
- (5) If there is a difference in the curricula of the courses taken, it will be determined by the corresponding difference of the subject or part of the subject that the student is required to pass.
- (6) The student is required during his or her further education at the University to pass the missing exams and to obtain necessary number of credits provided for enrollment in the following year, in accordance with the provisions of these Rules.

IV - ADMISSION TO THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE PREPARATORY PROGRAM

Article 15.

- (1) Candidates who to meet the requirements for admission to the third cycle studies, but failed to pass the exam in English language or did not pass the English proficiency exam, should be sent to the training organized by the Preparatory School of English.
- (2) Upon completion of the training, candidates are required to pass the exam in English language within the preparatory school or equivalent examination in another institution that organizes such types of training, and whose acceptability decided by the organizational unit.

V - ORGANIZATION OF THE THIRD CYCLE STUDIES

Article 16.

- (1) University or college of the University organize and implement the second cycle of studies in the field for which they are responsible.
- (2) The study of the second cycle is organized in the full number of hours provided the curriculum as a regular course of study as well as remotely.

VI - DISTANCE LEARNING - DL STUDY

Article 17.

- (1) Distance Learning is a formalized system of education where students are using computer technology and interactive teaching materials which provide the access to educational processes.
- (2) The study of the second cycle of studies at the International Burch University can be organized in a number of hours adapted to students who are unable to attend regular study as a study of distance.

Article 18.

- (1) When the classes or individual forms of teaching are organized in the form of "distance learning" exams are necessarily held in the headquarters of the organizational unit.
- (2) Practical work and professional practice can be organized and implemented as an integral part of the course at the headquarters of the University or in place of their realization.
- (3) The doctoral dissertation in the context of distance learning will be defended at the headquarters of the organizational unit. Exceptionally, the Council of the organizational unit may authorize the defense of the doctoral dissertation by video / internet connections.
- (4) For the Council of the organizational unit to approve the organizing the defense of the doctoral dissertation by video / internet connection, it is necessary that the student fulfils

the requests, the written approval of the mentor, and the evidence justifying such a way as defense.

- (5) In any case, the student must first fulfill all procedural and financial obligations to the University.

VII - THE DOCTORAL STUDY

Article 19.

- (1) Before the beginning of the Third Cycle Study, the study will be proposed to the Council of the Faculty of subject instructors who will participate in the third cycle.
- (2) The Doctoral Studies of the University consists of all heads of departments where teaching is conducted in the third cycle studies.
- (3) The council of doctoral studies is chaired by the President.
- (4) The President of the Council of Doctoral Studies of the University is appointed by the Senate from among the instructors employed at the University as assistant professor, associate professor and full professor.
- (5) In the absence of the President, the Council of doctoral study is chaired by a member of the president of the authority.
- (6) The position of the Chairman of the Council (the president of the authority) of doctoral study lasts three years with the possibility of re-election.

Article 20.

- (1) The Doctoral study is to address issues relating to the organization and course of study, and in particular:
 - a) tasks which by the law are explicitly defined as jobs of the Study Council;
 - b) other tasks which do not specifically fall under the Senate and the Council of the organizational unit.
- (2) The President reports to the University Senate.

VIII - COMMON / MULTIDISCIPLINARY STUDY PROGRAM

Article 21.

- (1) The University may organize and conduct studies of the second cycle for one or more scientific fields, in two or more faculties of the University or in conjunction with another higher education institution in the country or abroad, with the consent of the parent faculty (hereinafter jointly study) and in accordance with the law.
- (2) Joint studies may be organized by the faculties of scientific fields for which they are responsible.
- (3) Decision on forming a joint study is carried out by the Senate of the University.
- (4) The decision to organize joint study determines all questions for this study, and particularly the program of study, organizational studies, and academic title and the qualification obtained upon completion of studies.
- (5) The proponents of the joint study set out a program, which is to be adopted by the competent authorities of all the participants in the program.

Article 22.

The organizers of the joint study program sign a contract governing the terms and manner of executing instruction, procedures for approval and defense of the final work, the use of premises and equipment, conditions of acquisition and deployment of resources, management

studies, who will be tracking the student's development (registration, issuance of certificates, diplomas, etc.), and other rights and obligations of the joint study program.

IX - EVALUATION OF STUDENTS

Article 23.

- I** - The students must take their exams mid-semester and/or complete other projects/ homework during the semester, in addition, must take the final exam and/or complete a final project for the evaluation of a particular case.
- II** - The University will determine and announce the time and place of final exams.
- III** - The final assessment of students is given by the instructor.
- IV** - The final grade is based on the assessment of the partial examination, assessment of the final examination and / or evaluation of final project and record attendance.
- V** - Students who miss any examination may be granted additional examination, provided that the competent department determines that there was a valid reason for non-examination.

X - EVALUATION

Article 24.

For every exam that students are required to take, appointed professors are supposed to give one of the grades (numerical or letter) from the table below at the end of the semester. Evaluation system at IBU is the following:

XI - GPA

Article 25.

- (1) In order to learn student's GPA, arithmetic mean needs to be calculated.
- (2) All grades are presented in the transcript/certificate of the exams that student has passed.

XII - LOSS OF STUDENT STATUS

Article 26.

Student loses student status for the following reasons:

- a) completion the study cycle,
- b) withdrawal from the higher educational institution,
- c) the expulsion in accordance with the procedure and the requirements established by law, statute or other appropriate Article of the University,

- d) if s/he fails to register and verify the semester twice (2x) in a row,
- e) if the thesis proposal is rejected by the competent Committee twice,
- f) if student does not complete his/her study program within the specified deadline,
- g) as well as for the other reasons specified by other regulations of the University.

XIII - DOCTORAL PROGRAM - GOALS

Article 27.

- (1) Scope and aim of doctoral program is that students carry out their own research, express their opinion regarding the scientific achievements, and take the necessary steps in order to reach new scientific synthesis.
- (2) The doctoral dissertation must fulfill one of the following conditions:
 - a) demonstrate a new approach to the field of research,
 - b) use a new scientific method/approach,
 - c) apply existing methods to a new field of research.

Article 28.

- (1) Duration of the third cycle of studies is three academic years (six semesters), that is to say the scope of study program is 180 (E)CTS credits.
- (2) Doctoral study consists of at least 8 courses with the total minimum value of 60 ECTS, qualifying examination, the proposal of doctoral dissertation, three control tests of the dissertation, and dissertation.
- (3) The deadlines determined in this Article can be extended if there are reasonable grounds for the extension. The Committee of the organizational unit is responsible for this decision.

Article 29.

- (1) Study programs of the third cycle study are divided into study years and semesters.
- (2) In accordance with the European credit transfer system (E) CTS scope of the program is 30 (E) CTS credits in one semester.
- (3) Number of study credits for each subject is determined by the total student workload (theoretical and / or practical training, exercises, seminars, etc.), the time student spend working on independent tasks (homework, projects, seminars and the like.) and the time for learning in preparation for assessment and evaluation (tests, final exams and so on.).

Article 30.

- (1) The student has a right to spend some time (a semester or an academic year) on a related higher educational institution in the country or abroad, through the international students exchange program, on the basis of bilateral agreements concluded by the University or at the suggestion of the candidate with prior approval of the University.
- (2) The manner of carrying out the mobility of students is determined by the University Statute.

XIV - CONDITIONS FOR COURSE LECTURER AT THE DOCTORAL STUDY

Article 31.

- (1) The course lecturer in doctoral program can be a lecturer in all professions (Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Full Professor).

- (2) A course lecturer may be a practitioner and/or a Visiting Professor.
- (3) A mentor can be a lecturer in all professions (Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and Full Professor).

XV - SELECTION OF A MENTOR AND A COMMITTEE FOR A DEFENSE OF TOPIC PROPOSAL OF A DISSERTATION TOPIC AND SUPERVISION OF A DOCTORAL DISSERTATION

Article 32.

- (1) During the third semester, the student applies to the Council Organizational Unit proposal of the dissertation topic and mentor, provided that all the exams envisaged by the curriculum.
- (2) The proposed doctoral thesis should be signed by the student and mentor that student suggests. The Council of the organizational unit decides on the appointment of a mentor, and submits to the University Senate a draft decision on the appointment of the Commission for the Defense proposal for the topic and supervision of a doctoral dissertation consisting of 3 members.
- (3) The composition of the committee referred to in paragraph (2) of this Article, finally decided by the University Senate.
- (4) The amendments to the composition of the commission decides the Senate at the proposal of Council of the organizational unit.

XVI - MENTOR

Article 33.

- (1) Mentor is selected among the academic staff of the University, or other higher educational institution in the position of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and Full Professor in the scientific field, which doctoral dissertation belongs to.
- (2) The mentor in doctoral program is obliged to assist the student in selecting the method of scientific research, literature, preparing the structure of work, as well as in providing the expert assistance.
- (3) If the subject of a topic of doctoral dissertation requires more than one mentor, a co-mentor can be appointed.
- (4) In case of need, the Faculty Council may decide to replace the mentor/co-mentor.

XVII - DEFENSE OF THE THESIS PROPOSAL

Article 34.

- (1) Immediately after the appointment of the commission for defense topics proposals and supervision of a doctoral dissertation, the student is given a period not exceeding three months for the defense of dissertation proposal before the commission.
- (2) The Committee for the proposed topics and supervision of a doctoral dissertation submits a report on the Defense proposal for the topic Council of the organizational unit that makes the final decision on approval of the doctoral dissertation topic.
- (3) A student whose proposal is rejected has the right to demand a new mentor, and a new topic of a doctoral dissertation. In this case, the new Committee can be appointed. A student who wants to continue cooperation with the same mentor is obliged to defend his doctoral thesis proposal within one month after re-proposal, while the student who changed his mentor has a deadline of three months for re-defense of the proposal.

XVIII - ASSESSMENT OF A DISSERTATION PROGRESS

Article 35.

- (1) Once the Faculty Council approves a candidate's doctoral dissertation topic, the Committee for a defense of the proposal of dissertation topic and supervision of a doctoral dissertation meets at least twice a year, and more if necessary, all in order to examine the progress of writing the thesis.
- (2) The student submits a written report to the committee members 10 days before the date of the examination referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article. This report contains a summary of the written part of dissertation until that period, as well as a work plan for the next semester. Supervisory Committee provides an assessment S (successful) or U (unsuccessful).
- (3) The report on the progress of the doctoral thesis contains a summary of previously written part of the thesis, and work plan for the next semester. Supervisory Commission provides an assessment of S (successful) or N (unsuccessful).
- (4) The student must approach at least two times to the examination of the dissertation, and get ratings S - successful. If the student twice in a row to be judged as a failure, it will be excluded from the doctoral program.
- (5) If the student has applied for a change of dissertation topic, and before the application has successfully defended two reports on the progress of dissertation committee for defense proposal topics and supervision of a doctoral dissertation must meet at least once in order to examine the progress of the dissertation. Exceptionally, in case of a change of the topic that do not affect the content or substance of the doctoral dissertation, the committee may decide that the testing of the doctoral dissertation is not necessary.
- (6) If at the request of the student doctoral dissertation in whole or most part needs to be changed, the council of the organizational unit may propose to the University Senate the appointment of a new commission for defense topics proposals and supervision of a doctoral dissertation. The appointment of the new Commission is not necessary if a majority of the members previously appointed are the committee of scientific field of the new doctoral thesis.
- (7) During the last examination of the dissertation, members of the Commission in cooperation with the Office for publication determine that the thesis ready for defense, that it is not plagiarism, that is methodologically properly designed and that there is no need for changes or corrections in the work.
- (8) Defense of the thesis proposal and defense reports on the progress of the doctoral dissertation are organized at the headquarters of the organizational unit. Exceptionally, the Council of the organizational unit may, on a reasoned request to the student and the written approval of the mentor, approve the organization of the defense thesis proposal and defense report on progress of the dissertation via video / internet connections.

XIX - EVALUATION OF THE FINAL WORK

Article 36.

- (1) Students who successfully pass the courses from the curriculum must write a doctoral paper in English language (with the exception regarding the Department of Oriental Philology - Turkish Language and Literature, where the paper is to be written in Turkish), using data from their research, and by following the rules presented in the Regulation on the thesis development.

- (2) A student of doctoral program is obliged to publish articles, which are related to his doctoral thesis in indexed scientific journals, individually or in cooperation (co-authorship) with his mentor.
- (3) Minimal number of published articles in the international indexed journals is as follows:
 - a) at the Faculty of Engineering and Natural Sciences of International Burch University: - Two articles must be published in co-authorship with the supervisor, and at least one of them must be published in internationally indexed journals with SSCI or SCI/SCI-Expanded index for all departments except the Architecture department
- In the Architecture department, at least two articles must be published, and at least one of them must be in journal with AHCI index, Avery Index and DAAI (in co-authorship with the supervisor)
 - b) at the Faculty of Education and Humanities of International Burch University:
- Two articles must be published in co-authorship with the supervisor, and at least one of them must be published in internationally indexed journals with AHCI, SSCI or SCI/SCI-Expanded index with exception of Department of Oriental Philology where two articles must be indexed in international databases.
 - c) at the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences of International Burch University:
- Two articles must be published in co-authorship with the supervisor, and at least one of them must be published in internationally indexed journals with SSCI or SCI/SCI-Expanded index for all departments

XX - APPOINTMENT OF THE COMMISSION FOR EVALUATION AND DEFENSE OF THE DOCTORAL DISSERTATION

Article 37.

- (1) Upon completion of the doctoral thesis, the student shall submit a written request for scheduling assessment and defense of the doctoral dissertation to the Secretary of the organizational unit. Along with the application, shall be submitted to and evidence of publications, reports from the official records of passed exams and ECTS points, and a sufficient number of copies of the thesis.
- (2) The student shall submit one copy of the PhD thesis in electronic form to the Office for publication in order to determine that this is not plagiarism. More detailed procedures related to plagiarism governing internal act of the Office for Publications.
- (3) The documentation referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be submitted to the Commission for assessment and defense of the doctoral dissertation, together with the decision on the appointment of the Commission.
- (4) the Commission for assessment and defense of doctoral dissertation is appointed by the Senate on the proposal of the organizational units within 30 days of filing a proper application to the Secretary of the organizational unit. Commission consisting of 3 to 5 members, of which at least one member can be called from another university. Mentor is a member of the Commission on the situation. Exceptionally, if a member of the Commission from another university or another member be prevented attends defending the dissertation, except mentors whose presence is required, as a member of the Commission may appear a replacement member who was appointed to the Senate.
- (5) The Secretary of the organizational unit is a member of the Commission without the right to vote, with the task of carrying out administrative and technical aspects of the defense of the doctoral dissertation.
- (6) The Commission shall prepare and submit a report on the doctoral dissertation (short presentation of the dissertation: set goals, the methods applied, the results and conclusions of the research realized) Council of the organizational unit within 30 days of receipt of the dissertation. During the examination of the dissertation, the Commission may return to the same student for revision and amendment, and set a time limit (which may not be less than

20 days nor longer than 2 months) in which the obligation to be enforced. If the Commission decides that doctoral dissertation is not after finishing the amendments do not meet the criteria necessary for the defense of same, will propose to the Council of the organizational unit to deny his doctoral dissertation. In this case, the student may submit a proposal for a new doctoral thesis within 30 days of receipt of the decision to reject.

- (7) Upon receipt of the report the Commission, the Council of the organizational unit proposes to the University Senate decision on the report of the commission and the acceptance or rejection of the doctoral dissertation.
- (8) The final decision on the report of the commission for evaluation and defense of doctoral dissertation is made by the Senate of the University within 30 days of receipt of the report committee. If the Senate does not accept the report of the commission, the student can make corrections dissertation in accordance with the remarks in a period not exceeding 30 days. If the Senate decides that doctoral dissertation is not after finishing the amendments do not meet the criteria necessary for the defense of same, will make a decision on the refusal of the doctoral thesis. In this case, the student may submit a proposal for a new doctoral thesis within 30 days of receipt of the decision to reject.
- (9) If the Senate accepts the report of the commission, the student can access the defense of the doctoral dissertation after the expiry of at least 15 days after the decision on the adoption of the report the commission that the student has successfully made his doctoral thesis. The decision to adopt the report and the date of the defense of the doctoral dissertation submitted to the student and posted on the notice board of the organizational unit. Date of Defense is also published on the official website of the organizational unit.
- (10) If a student fails the defense of the doctoral dissertation, he or she once again has the right to defense of the doctoral dissertation of the same or to request to have an election of a new darkness. The decision on the application of the candidate for change of mentor and dissertation topics adopted by the Senate of the University on the proposal of the Council of the organizational unit.
- (11) The form of defense of the doctoral dissertation is determined by the Senate. The defense of the doctoral dissertation, consisting of practical and oral exams can be realized in two parts for a period not exceeding seven days after carrying out the practical part of the exam. If the thesis consists of two parts (practical demonstrations and oral exam) student will first do the practical part and then start oral defense of the written part of the dissertation.
- (12) At the end of the examination, the Commission will in camera to make a decision, "approved", "denied" or "repetition of Defense". A candidate whose dissertation is judged "rejected" may re-apply with a new dissertation within one year after the rejection of the dissertation, and the candidate whose dissertation is assessed as "repetition of Defense" may re-apply for the defense of the same for a period of 3 months after the decision Commission. In these cases, the Senate, at the proposal of the Council of the organizational unit, and following a request from the student, appoint a new commission for evaluation and defense of doctoral dissertation. Students are required registration each semester. A student whose defense of the doctoral dissertation is twice evaluated as "rejected" loses the student status.

XXI - DOCUMENTS AND RECORDS OF THE STUDY PROGRAM

Article 38.

- (1) A student who has passed all the exams of the study program of the third cycle of studies, defended the thesis, and fulfilled all other obligations under the Statute of the University and these Regulations, acquires the academic title, master in a specific field, that is to say, a diploma of completion of the third cycle of the study program.
- (2) With a diploma, a student receives the diploma supplement for a detailed insight into the level, nature, content, study program's system and regulations, and the results achieved during the study program.

Article 39.

- (1) Before awarding a diploma, a student needs to receive a certificate of completion of the third cycle of studies in which it is stated that it is temporary.
- (2) The University Senate determines the date of a graduation ceremony for awarding diplomas of completion of the third cycle of studies.

XXII - TRANSITIONAL AND FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 40.

University Statute and Regulations for first and second cycle of the university studies are to be applied for other issues related to the organization and way of teaching, and for the rights and obligations of students during their studies, which are not regulated by these Regulations.

Article 41.

The rules will come into force upon their adoption, and will apply starting from the 2017/2018 academic year.
